Ernest Max Trummer Collection

(Collection 10)

Scope and Content

Ernest Max Trummer (1875-1960) immigrated to the United States from Germany at the age of 17. While living in Nebraska, he accepted the Seventh-day Adventist message which he learned from neighbors. He attended Union College and then was called to the South American Union to organize colporteur work. He met his wife, Noema Fontana, in Buenos Aires. They both took a break from work in South America to attend Washington Missionary College. Following graduation, they were called to Central America where they worked until 1942. Their service in Colombia resulted in church membership of more than 2,000 at the time of their retirement. The Trummers had two children: a son, Max J. Trummer and daughter, Mrs. M. D. Hannah.

This collection contains a brief biography written by Trummer's son, copies of photographs, and Trummer's personal copy of *The Desire of Ages*.
