William Vanostrand Albee was born July 3, 1897 in Weyauwego, Wisconsin and died January 3, 1983 in Calimesa, California. He graduated from Union College in 1924. During his career, Albee was principal of San Diego Academy, and taught at Hawaiian Mission and Loma Linda academies.

This collection contains Albee's 1924 Union College annual, the *Golden Cords*, which is filled with the autographs of classmates and teachers, and additional items found inside the annual.
