Scope and Content

Fannie Adelia Adams Taylor Spaulding was born January 26, 1887 in Half Rock, Missouri and died May 15, 1977 in Decatur, Illinois. She graduated from Union College in 1916. During her life, Spaulding worked as a colporteur in Nebraska and later worked for the Christian Record Braille Foundation. She also pioneered business Ingathering in Los Angeles, California and Lincoln, Nebraska.

This collection contains Spaulding's 1916 Union College scrapbook. Additional items shelved elsewhere in the Heritage Room include a school pendent.
